You can waive your English course requirement only if you have obtained a degree from Australia, Belize, the British Caribbean and British West Indies, Canada (except Quebec), England, Guyana, Ireland, Liberia, New Zealand, Scotland, the United States and Wales or if you have taken some official English test to prove your English ability to the level equivalent to or higher than the intermediate level in The General English Proficiency Test (GEPT).
